## Pulling for People FAQ

### **Q: When is the Bus Pull?**

A: June 21st, 1PM, @1253 NW 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave, Oak Harbor Washington (360) 679-1561

### **Q: What is a bus pull?**

A: A “**bus pull**” is basically tug of war with a bus. In this event in which people in teams of up to 8 pull a bus a measured distance. Before the event participants (both people riding on the bus and the people pulling the bus) collect pledges. The pledges are donations that people are willing to give based on how far the bus gets pulled.

### **Q: What happens with the money that is raised during this event?**

A: 50 percent of the money raised up to \$50,000 will be used to help a family with at least one disabled member chosen prior to the event by the Oak Harbor Lutheran Church Youth Group. Any remaining funds up to \$50,000 will be donated to the VA hospital for the purpose of aiding disabled veterans purchase equipment they need. If there are any funds raised above \$100,000 they will be used to create an endowment for future events. All monies donated will be earmarked for helping disabled individuals be it remodeling a home, or purchasing needed equipment. In future events a small percentage, less than \$1000 can be used to advertise the event, and purchase any needed materials for running the event.

### **Q: Who can pull a bus?**

A: Any team of up to eight people can pull a bus. Some people have already committed to attempt to pull a bus by themselves. The key thing is getting as many people as you can to collect enough pledges to ride on the bus. For each bus pull we would like to see at least ten people riding the bus.

### **Q: How does the pledge system work?**

A: People who pledge money would pledge a certain amount of money for each foot that the bus is pulled. People pledging money should understand that the first foot is free, which means that the minimum donation will be for one foot. The person pledging money can set a maximum amount that they are willing to donate. After the event the person who collected the pledges will be responsible for collecting all moneys pledged.

### **Q: How much money do you need to raise in order to ride the bus?**

A: We are asking that people wishing to ride the bus collect a minimum of \$50 a foot in pledges. We are also asking that people pulling the bus ensure that they have at least 10 people with enough pledges to ride.
